IMPORTANT CHANGES TO YOUR EMHP BENEFITS

IN-NETWORK PROVIDER COPAY CHANGES EFFECTIVE SETPEMBER 1, 2017

As part of our continuing effort to provide our members with important updates regarding the Employee Medical Health Plan of Suffolk County (EMHP), the Labor/Management Committee, which oversees the EMHP, would like to provide you with important information concerning an increase in your **in-network copayments**.

Effective **September 1, 2017**, the following co-payments will apply to covered services rendered under the EMHP. These in-network copay changes supersede those stated in the 2012 EMHP Benefit Booklet. All other plan rules and

guidelines apply.
