

CLARIFICATION ON FILING OF IRS FORM 1095-C FOR 2015

This AEM is a clarification to All-Employees Memorandum 01-16 issued on January 14, 2016, regarding the Reporting and Dissemination of Tax Information Forms under the Affordable Care Act (Form 1095-C).

Please be advised that the timing of the distribution of Form 1095-C by the County <u>WILL</u> <u>NOT</u> affect the distribution of or impact the wage and salary information on the Form W-2.

In addition, the County has clarification from the IRS that the 1095-C form is \underline{NOT} required for the completion and submission of employee income tax filings for 2015. However, the IRS recommends that you keep the 1095-C Form with your important tax documents for the 2015 tax year.

You should seek the advice of a tax consultant regarding any questions that you may have in determining how PPACA affects your tax filing or how to utilize the informational returns in preparing your individual tax return.
