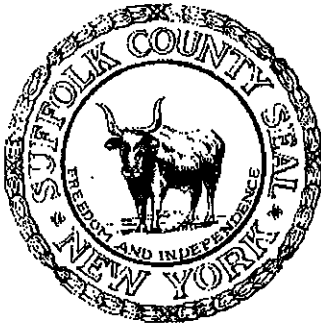

**EMPLOYEE MEDICAL HEALTH PLAN OF SUFFOLK COUNTY (EMHP)
ANNUAL NOTICE OF WOMEN'S HEALTH AND CANCER RIGHTS
ACT OF 1998**

The Employee Medical Health Plan of Suffolk County (EMHP), as required by the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998, provides benefits for mastectomy-related services including all stages of reconstruction and surgery to achieve symmetry between the breasts, prostheses, and complications resulting from a mastectomy, including lymphedemas. If you have had or are going to have a mastectomy, you may be entitled to certain benefits under the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 (WHCRA). For individuals receiving mastectomy-related benefits, coverage will be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and the patient, for:


- All stages of reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed;
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance;
- Prostheses; and
- Treatment of physical complications of the mastectomy, including lymphedemas.

These benefits will be provided subject to the same deductibles and 20 percent co-payments applicable to other medical and surgical benefits provided under this plan.

When you use a non-participating provider in the EMHP, you are responsible for the:

- Deductible of \$550; plus
- 20 percent co-payment; plus
- Charges above reasonable and customary.
